VINTAGE SUMMARY: The 2021 Vintage can be classified as a severe drought year here in Napa Valley. With only 7.3" of rain from January to March, bud break was early, and bloom had higher stress than typical — leading to a smaller crop. Currently, I'm drawing comparisons in the cellar to the 2015 vintage, but with much less heat towards the end of the growing season, helping retain freshness and varietal expression and individuality. Overall, a very high-quality vintage (if you had water to irrigate with, which we luckily did), I foresee the vintage to be known for its structure, freshness, and long-term age-ability.

winemaker's tasting notes: The 2021 JFC Signature is the yin to the 2021 JFC Maverick's yang. A Bordeaux style blend, but with a healthy spike of Tannat. While the Maverick provides more immediate drinkability to the lineup, the Signature is designed to be more structured and age-worthy. Immediately upon opening the bottle, Signature shows an amazing florality. Raspberry, a hint of fresh bramble verdancy, and high toned cassis. The attack is opulent, but fresh, with hints of orange oil, bread from the Cabernet Sauvignon and Malbec. The unique Tannat addition provides tension and verve to the blend, while also creating the Signature's long, bright, and structured finish.
