Aromatics are primarily red, but hit parts of the entire spectrum, encapsulating a core of clear cassis and ethereal white flowers. The palate is supple yet beautifully refined with a center of ripe raspberries surrounded by layers of graphite, lavender, and a lite brambly spice.
