good flavor and strong skins.

Winemaker's The classic nose is highlighted by blackberry, Tasting Notes: black currant, blueberry, dark chocolate, soy,

tar, with hints of oregano and mint.

A black raspberry attack leads an intensely flavored rich mouth of boysenberry, black cherry, plum, black tea, tobacco, and sage; surrounded by well integrated milk chocolate tannins. It finishes clean with a long lasting

cherry, red currant aftertaste.
